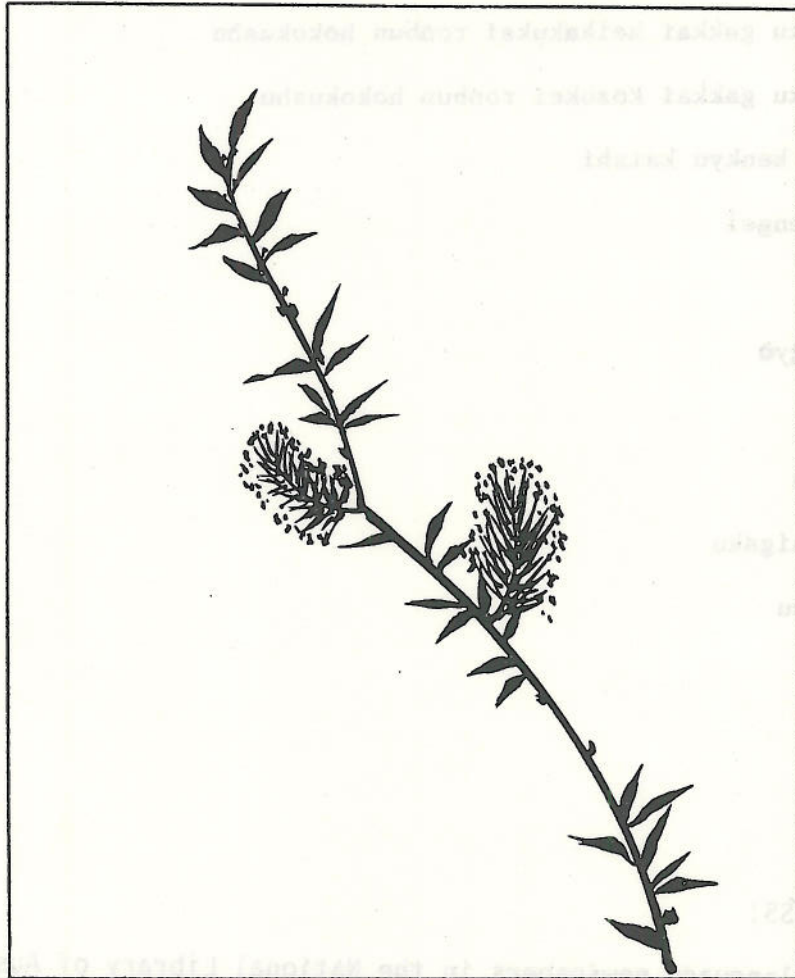

Chinese

For the Chinese collection, the most important acquisition is the 203 volume reprint set of Ch'ing tai ch'i chü chu ts'e (Notes on the daily lives of the Ch'ing emperors) which covers the reigns of K'ang-hsi (1662-1722), Tao-kuang (1821-1850), Hsien-feng (1851-1861) and T'ung-chih (1862-1874). These notes describe not only the daily lives of the emperors but also the court activities and ministers' reports which are the primary sources used to compile the shih lu (Veritable records) after the death of the emperor. Comparison of the ch'i chü chu and shih lu have revealed that the former is much more detailed and should be regarded as primary research material for the study of Ch'ing history.

In addition to the ch'i chü chu, other important additions to the collection, which can be classified into three categories as follows, are:
