### THE KOREAN DEPARTMENT RENOVATION PROJECT IN THE HARVARD-YENCHING LIBRARY

A major construction project involving the renovation of the Korean Department of the Harvard-Yenching Library at Harvard University will be carried out in the summer of 2001. The Korean Collection will be moved off-site and will be inaccessible from June 11 to September 3, 2001. The collection will be returned to the Library on Tuesday, September 4, 2001, following Labor Day.

During this construction period, a small and highly selective working collection will be maintained in the Department of East Asian Languages and Civilization adjacent to the Harvard-Yenching Library to meet the needs of Harvard's Korean Studies faculty, students, and visiting scholars who will be in residence in the summer. The Korean Department staff will continue to be available to provide library and reference services, and the Korean reference collection in the Reading Room will also be accessible. The Library's other departments and collections will not be affected.

Please inform your Korean Studies faculty and students of this renovation project. Korean Studies scholars are advised to plan their research trips to the Harvard-Yenching Library accordingly.
